Privacy and Data Protection Statement

Hitchin Youth Trust is committed to protecting your privacy. This statement explains how we collect and use the personal information you provide to us.

By applying for a grant and providing us with any personal information we will assume you are agreeing to your information being used and disclosed in the ways described in this policy.

Who we are?

Hitchin Youth Trust is a registered as a charity in England and Wales (registered charity number 302398) and we are also registered as a company limited by guarantee (company number 00399872).

Our aim is to support activities for young people up to the age of 26 who have lived in the geographical area of the trust for at least 12 months. We do this by providing financial support to both individuals and Youth Organisations and we can also provide a place to meet at our premises in Hitchin. Grant Aid is also available for training courses for Leaders of Youth Organisations.

Data Protection Act

In carrying out our grant awarding activity we process and store personal information relating to our applicants and we are therefore required to adhere to the requirements of the General Data Protection Regulation 2018. We take our responsibilities under this act very seriously and we ensure the personal information we obtain is held, used, transferred and otherwise processed in accordance with this Regulation and all other applicable data protection laws and regulations including, but not limited to, the Privacy and Electronic Communication Regulations.

What personal information do we collect?

Personal information is information that can be used to identify you and your children. It includes your name, date of birth, email address, postal address, telephone number, mobile telephone number, employment details including salary and benefit information. We collect personal information about you when you apply for a grant. Applications can also include 'sensitive personal information' as this can be supportive to your application to give a clearer picture of the situation.

Copies of application forms are sent to Trustees prior to our monthly meetings in order for them to assess the information and give it fair consideration when making decisions on awarding the grants.

All Trustees have signed a 'Confidentiality Agreement' and are aware of their responsibilities when handling personal data. After every meeting the copies of the applications are destroyed and only the originals and minutes kept in a locked office and recorded on our computer. Our computer is backed up with our IT Company and all systems used are GDPR compliant. Access to the computer is via a log on and password. This is only available to Hitchin Youth Trust office staff and Trustees.

Why do we collect and how do we use your information?

We collect your personal information for a number of reasons, such as:

- to help make fair and informed decisions when awarding grants
- to provide information to our auditors of the money we spend on charitable purposes

We will not use your information for marketing purposes.



Information sharing and disclosure

We will not sell or swap your information with any third party.

We may share your information with other local charities if we believe that they can better meet your needs. Your information may also be shared with our IT Contractor. These are trusted partner organisations that work with us in connection with our charitable purposes. All our trusted partners are required to comply with data protection laws and our high standards and are only allowed to process your information in strict compliance with our instructions. We will always make sure appropriate controls are in place and we regularly monitor all our partners to ensure their compliance.

We may disclose your personal information to third parties if we are required to do so through a legal obligation (for example to the police or a government body); to enable us to enforce or apply our terms and conditions or rights under an agreement; or to protect us, for example, in the case of suspected fraud or defamation.

We do not share your information for any other purposes.

Storing your information

All of the information we store and process stays within the UK and is therefore covered by GDPR.

We will keep your information for as long as required to enable us to operate our services but we will not keep your information for any longer than is necessary. We will take into consideration our legal obligations and tax and accounting rules when determining how long we should retain your information. When we no longer need to retain your information we will ensure it is securely disposed of, at the appropriate time.

Your rights

You have the right to:

- request a copy of the information we hold about you;
- ask us to remove your personal information from our records;
- raise a concern or complaint about the way in which your information is being used.
